

Directions to Kittery Point Yacht Club

Please note. The KPYC is on New Castle Avenue, or Route 1B, the road from Portsmouth to New Castle Island. There is no direct route, however, have faith, these directions will get you there. This route will take you through downtown Portsmouth and then to New Castle Ave., also known as Route 1B.

If you get lost, call the KPYC and someone will answer to give you directions. If there is no answer there, call John Mayer at (603) 422-9551 or Peter Follansbee at (603) 436-4956.

From the North

Take Interstate 95 South to New Hampshire
Take Exit 7. (The first exit after crossing the Piscataqua River Bridge.)
At bottom of ramp, go left on Market St.

From the South

Take Interstate 95 North to New Hampshire.
Take exit 7. (The last exit in NH.)
At bottom of ramp go right on Market St.

On Market St. Go south 1.0 miles. To Bow St.

Keep towards the left through the flashing light at the RR crossing, pass the Portsmouth Sheraton on the right, salt piles on left. Market Street jogs to the left, narrows, and begins to climb a small hill. There is a stop sign at Hanover St.

Approximately 50 yards after the stop sign, **turn left on Bow St.**

Stay on Bow St. which begins to curve right and climb a hill. At the top of the hill **Bow St. turns right, and becomes Chapel St.** (The St. John Church and cemetery is at the top of the hill and ahead/to the left of you.)

Stay on Chapel St. for two blocks.

You will come to a stop sign at Daniel St. and State St.

Turn left at the second stop sign on State Street.

Get over to the right side of the street. Keep to the right here--**DO NOT GO OVER THE BRIDGE!**
There is a right lane that avoids the ramp to the bridge. Keep to the right and at the first street,

Turn right on Marcy St. Keep on Marcy Street for .3 miles to a stop sign.

(Marcy Street takes you through one of the older sections of town. Strawberry Banke museum is on the right. Prescott Park and the Piscataqua River is on the left.)

Turn left at the stop sign at Pleasant St.

Keep to the left for another .2 miles until you come to a stop sign at New Castle Avenue.

Turn left on New Castle Avenue. Go .75 miles to the KPYC on the left.

You will go over two small bridges. After the second bridge, the KPYC is about 100 yards on the left. KPYC is a gray shingled, one-story building with two red doors. There is a parking area in front of the building. The red door to the left is the club entrance.
